Again, all scale judging will take place on WEDNESDAY Oct.21st from 1PM until finish at 930 S. Sundance Parkway [Ballroom]. No one admitted until 1PM except Vendors.

Bring your models and documentation. Documentation should include: a three-view, and documentation supporting the color, markings and details you used. A plan is optional. Photos are optional, but if used, will supersede the 3-view if different. Mass Launch aircraft not entered in FAC Rubber Scale will be judged using a modified" Check List at the Scale Judging. A special set of Judges will be used for this check. All radial engine models in Mass Launch events must have at least a paper engine inside the cowl. All military models in Mass Launch must have armament built into the model—no "painted on guns". No slab-sided models unless the real aircraft was slab-sided. No folding props in any events. **No rubber limits on any event.**
