General Contest Notes

The \$30.00 entry fee covers all events.

PPLC Compliance checks and Dime Scale / Simplified Scale / Embryo / Jet Cat bonus points awarded at GHQ tent Friday and Saturday mornings.

* Any racing aircraft, any era, any size.

** Rubber-powered jet or rocket aircraft including hybrids. See field notes for complete information.

*** Power Scale judging will be done at GHQ tent Sunday morning.

Awards will be presented at the field at the end of flying on Sunday.

NBM means No Blue Max

For Mass Launch events, depending on the drift, a delayed launch procedure may be used to reduce chase times.

RDTs (Radio-activated Dethermalizers) are allowed for this contest but NO fuse-DTs are permitted.

Note: If 3 or more flyers have a class of models not shown on the event schedule, check with the CD to see if a special event can be arranged.
