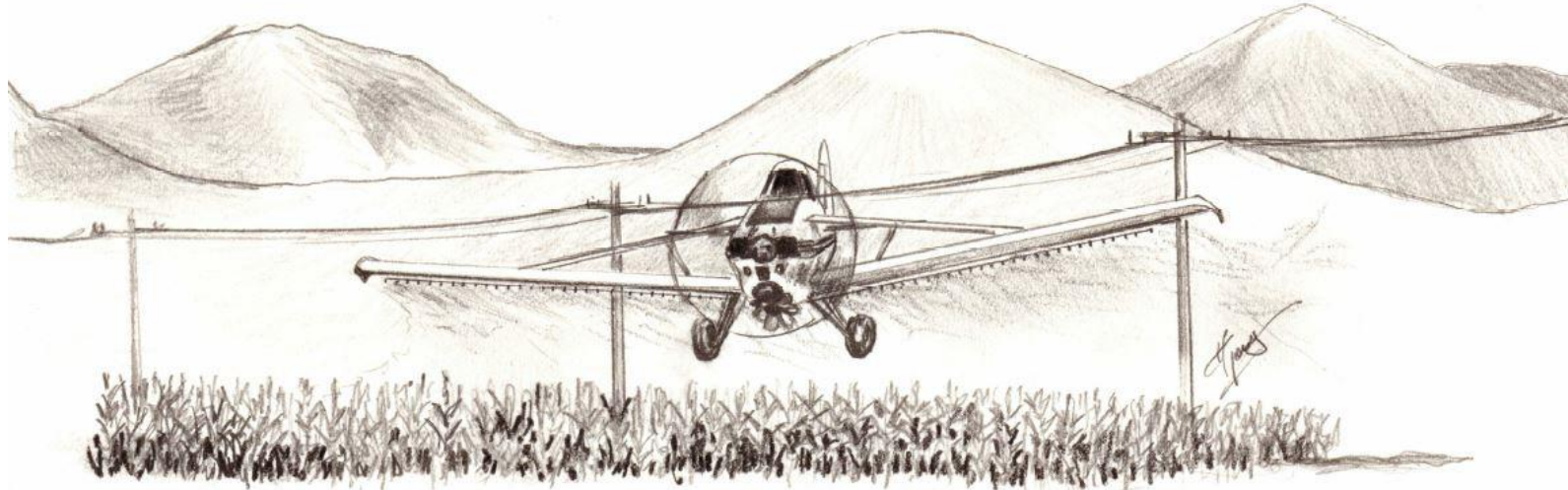

- All working aircraft must have markings indicating commercial usage. Marking documentation must be provided upon request.
- There are no formal judged scale events. PPLC compliance checks and Dime Scale/Simplified Scale judging will be done on the field.
- Awards will be presented on the field at the end of flying on Sunday. Kanones will be awarded for first place.
- Carrier event - any naval aircraft with a tailhook is eligible.
- Saturday Mass Launches will have the 2-4" Motor Restriction: An un-braided, unwound motor may extend no more than 2" from the nose of an inline engine, and 4" for radial engines.
- Sunday Mass Launches may have an unlimited motor size but we will use the Delayed Launch in which the prop is released 3-4 seconds before the aircraft are launched.
